Popular digital services OneClickdigital and Zinio for Libraries are merging! Both products will be known as RBdigital, with a single app. OneClickdigital's app will prompt users to update before proceeding, while users of Media Manager should receive an email to download a software upgrade.



### Robotics Come to Life at Teen Tech Camp

During June's Teen Tech Camp at Rock Hill Main Library, young engineers in the making learned simple circuit-building and programming skills to get hands on with cool droids, robotics, and more.

Working in teams, the teens built a 4-wheeled obstacle-avoiding robot car they could control by remote and smartphone. They also created projects with a DuinoKit, a printed circuit board featuring LEDs, buzzer, clock, LCD display, RF communication, and more.
